



WAX MELTER

READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USE. RETAIN FOR FUTURE REFERENCE.

Failure to follow these instructions could result in a fire hazard. Use only with good quality wax melts.

Not intended for use with fragranced warming oil or potpourri refresher oil.

Basic precautions should always be followed including the following:

- Remove all packaging before use.
- Read all instructions before using this product.
- Do not put fingers or hands into the unit.
- Do not immerse in water.
- Keep foreign objects out of the wax pool.
- The wax melter becomes very hot during use, do not touch or move whilst in use or whilst wax remains molten.
- Do not add water to the wax melts. Do not leave the melter unattended. Keep out of reach of children & pets.

DIRECTION FOR USE:

Place unit on a level, flat, cool, heat resistant surface away from draughts, other heat sources and flammable objects. If used on a non-heat resistant surface damage may occur if the unit is used without a protective plate, tray, or similar product.

Position the wax melt segment on the top bowl of the wax melter.

Only insert a tealight at the bottom when in use.

Allow the heat to melt the wax and fragrance will release into the room.

Ensure the melter is well ventilated, there must be space above the flame within the holder.

If no wax remains in the bowl allow to cool before refilling the bowl.

If wax remains in the bowl after use and you wish to remove the wax, wait until the wax cools, and hardens, and then gently place pressure on one end of the wax to pop the wax out.

Let the melter completely cool before re-use.

Do not use metal objects to clean out the wax. Do not apply excessive pressure when cleaning or removing wax. This may crack and damage the melter. Do not place the melter in a freezer.
